Transport/Shuttle Service

Official airport: Arlanda Airport, 225 km from Arlanda to Falun, Lugnet.

From Arlanda airport, follow route E4 towards Gävle. Turn on E16 towards Falun/
Oslo ~ 2hrs 30 min

From Oslo, follow route E16 towards Falun/Gävle ~ 5hrs

The organizing committee will arrange transportation between the airports and the hotels. Price for additional transport:

40 € one way

80 € return ticket
