## COVID-19 Prevention concept

### 1) General safety and hygiene rules

- a) The present COVID-19 prevention concept was developed on the basis of the current COVID-19 measures law in connection with the currently valid COVID-19 relaxation regulations and COVID-19 recommendations for action of the ministries.
- b) For all COVID-19- preventive measures Dietmar Wichenthaler is classified as prevention representative of the organizer.
- c) It is requested to carry out fever scans and superficial health checks and interviews with the teams on own responsibility before arrival. Should symptoms of illness be detected, participation is to be refrained and the organizer is to be informed.
- d) We advise all participants to keep a minimum distance of 1 meter between persons in indoor and outdoor areas.
- e) Masks are compulsory in the entire event area, especially on all public areas (marked yellow on the map), when collecting the start numbers and in the access and entry areas.
- f) Athletes, servicestaff/coaches and other persons present at the competition sites, who show symptoms of illness, are not allowed to enter the facilities/areas for training and competition.

### 2) Wax-cabins and sportfacility-buildings

- a) In the wax cabins (approx. 16m<sup>2</sup>) maximum 5 persons may stay at the same time.
- b) For the use of the wax cabins a reservation is necessary. A deposit of € 50,- must be paid before handing over the keys.
- c) When handing out the keys for the wax cabins, trainers/coaches will take the responsibility of the internal company regulations for surface disinfection. When entering and leaving the wax cabin daily, all surfaces must be cleaned with the disinfectant provided for this purpose.
- d) The trainers/coaches are obliged to give the names of all participants and visitors of the assigned wax cabins in the office (contact tracing)

### 3) Competition and training areas

- a) All competition and training areas may only be entered by persons who are wearing a bib. (marked red and green on the map)
- b) A mouth and nose protection must be worn during training.
- c) Athletes have to wear a Mouth and nose protection during the whole training/competition, except the immediate execution of the jump. The mouth/nose guard can be removed during start-up before the material check, after leaving the outlet the mouth/nose guard must be put on again
- d) When entering the pre-start area mouth-nose protection is mandatory. (marked light green in the plan)
- e) Mouth and nose protection is mandatory for the transponder issue.
- f) Mouth and nose protection is mandatory when leaving the Finish area.



#### **4) Coaches and servicestaff**

- a) Coaches and servicestaff may only enter the competition or training areas with Bibs. (Marked red and green on the map).
- b) In the pre-start area, a marked area (Coaching Beginning-Coaching End) is assigned, which must not be left.

#### **5) Measures in case of suspicion**

- a) If a COVID-19 suspected case is known during the event, the person concerned must immediately contact the COVID-19 representative and the COVID-19 representative must immediately locate the suspected case. All further steps/measures (separation, grounding, cancellation, etc.) must be carried out in coordination with the COVID-19 representative.
- b) If a COVID-19 suspected case becomes known after the event, it must be reported immediately to the COVID-19 representative.

All persons involved in the training/competition must comply with the above mentioned measures.

The organizer has the householder's rights in the entire event area, especially in the start and finish area and all public areas of the facility. The organizer is responsible at any time, persons or groups in the entire area to expel those who do not comply with the measures to protect the general public.
