The payment of costs for athletes will be according to the FIS rules.

Shuttle Service airport - Hotel – Venue

Train every 20 minute from Gardermoen (airport) to Drammen and hotel River Station. The train station is about 200 meters from the hotel. We prefer that you take the train for the sake of efficiency and the environment.

If it is not possible to take the train so the transportation to and from the airport will cost 20 EURO one way or 30 EURO both ways, however we need to be informed about your flight number in order to arrange the transportation. LOC will provide regular shuttle service free of charge between the team hotel and the venue. Look for the bus schedule at the Service Desk in the hotel.

Deadline for booking of transportation is 2 December (same date as final entries). Please use the FIS online system to register your demands for transportation.

Competition rules

The competition will be held in compliance with FIS international Competition Rules (ICR).

Participation

The number of participants in the competitions must comply with the official FIS competition rules and regulations.

Insurance

All athletes have to be insured through their National Ski Federations.

The organizer is not responsible for any personal injuries or damage to property that might occur. All participants must have an adequate insurance cover against accidents, illness and civil liability.

Entries

The registration of entries and accommodation should be done through the FIS online system.

The deadline for preliminary entries (number of rooms/participants): 29 October.

The deadline for final entries (names of participants/roomlist): 2 December

Doping control will be carried out according FIS Anti-Doping Rules.

Covid 19

Entry to Norway requires a EU/EEA approved Covid certificate (vaccinated or previously infected) or arrival from a country/area with low infection rates defined by the Norwegian authorities.

All other persons will be assigned a test slot and are subject to quarantine according to the Norwegian requirements at the date of the event. For the moment this demands antigen test every day for the first three days and then a PCR minimum 72 hours upon arrival.

For the first three days in Norway these persons also have to stay in single rooms and are subject to quarantine at all times except during training, competitions and other parts of the official program.

At the moment there are no specific restrictions for sport events or everyday life within Norway. Please be aware that this may change before the date of the competition.
