Closing time for entries:

Deadline for the entry is December 3rd . For entries arriving later than the deadline, the organizing committee cannot guarantee smooth travel and accommodation arrangements.

Competition rules:

The FIS rules will apply. The number of participants must comply with official FIS competition rules and regulations.

Insurance:

All competitors are to be insured by their own Ski Association and must have signed the Athletes Declaration. The Organizers have coverage for their own third party liability only. The Organizers will ask for Insurance documents and allow their right to keep the jumpers out of competition if they do not seem to be insured.

Accommodation:

All booking according to COC Women will be arranged by the Organizing Committee. The women will stay at Notodden Hotell. Teams arrival Thursday 16 dec. 2021

FIS jumpers Men must book their own accommodation and arrange their transportation. See www.bohotell.no . FIS Men book via online booking, and write **"HEDDAL BOOKING" in the note**. Then the hotel changes the price to the agreed price with Heddal IL in their system, and then everyone pay on departure.

Payment of expenses:

The Organising Committee will cover the accommodation expenses for COC Women competitors and the foreign TD and judges according to the FIS COCJ rule 6.1.

(The quota is 4 competitors and 1 coach)

Transportation for COC Women:

Train transfer from Oslo Airport Gardermoen to Kongsberg, and bus from Kongsberg to Notodden. Return with bus to Kongsberg, and Train to Oslo Airport Gardermoen. Bus will be provided by the Organizing Committee.

Transport cost:

Price per person for Train and Bus transport organized of the OC from Oslo Airport to the hotel in Notodden and return is: NOK 500 / 50 Euro

The costs for transport must be paid to the OC in the OC Finance Office at the race office in the hill during the weekend.

Regarding transportation from the hotel to the jumping arena, the delegates will be informed at the hotel on Thursday and Friday evening. This is for COC Women.

Doping control:

Doping control during the event may be carried out by our national antidoping organization. According to regulations, all participants shall be under an obligation to submit themselves to doping control.

Cancellation:

The decision concerning cancellation will be taken according to FIS rules. You can read about the decision on our website; www.heddalhopp.no

Prize-money COC W and FC M:

– divided by the first 6 athletes NSAs are responsible for entering the personal bank information for each athlete using the Athlete Registration module in the FIS Member Section

COVID 19

Entry to Norway requires a EU/EEA approved Covid certificate (vaccinated or previously



infected) or arrival from a country/area with low infection rates defined by the Norwegian authorities.

All other persons will be assigned a test slot and are subject to quarantine according to the Norwegian requirements at the date of the event. For the moment this demands antigen test every day for the first three days and then a PCR minimum 72 hours upon arrival.

For the first three days in Norway these persons also have to stay in single rooms and are subject to quarantine at all times except during training, competitions and other parts of the official program.

Price for testing:

Antigen test at the arrival airport/border is for free.

For testing at the hotel: Antigen test: 50 Euros

PCR test before departure: 80 Euros (need to be booked in advance)

MEDICAL INFORMATION

Covid – 19 – guidelines for the COC and FIS Cup event in Notodden 17th and 18th of December 2021

Main focus is kept distance and use face mask at all times.

It is established test-station at Notodden Hotell where everyone can make an Antigen quick-test.

Test station has following opening hours:

- Thursday 16th of December – from 16.00 – until 20.00
- Friday 17th of December – from 08.00 – 09.00
- Saturday 18th of December – from 08.00 – 09.00

In addition, it will be established a test-station in the hill with the following opening hours:

- Friday 16th of December – from 08.00 – 09.00
- Friday 16th of December – from 14.00 – 15.00

Persons subject to quarantine (athletes and staff arriving to Norway without an EU/EEA approved Covid certificate), are obliged to take an antigen test daily.

Is there any injury or illness, the medical personnel will order AMK and ordering additional ambulances for these patients that should continue to local or Central-Hospital,

Ambulance and medics personnel don't must travel from the ski jumping hill and stop Scheduled jumping. (This will only occur with rapid processing of patient to hospital)

If someone falls or being injured in hill, training or competition will be stopped at once, and will not start again before medical personnel is back in hill.

All medical personnel will get coursed in taking off bindings and other equipment before ski-jumping start.

The Hospital is informed that it is Ski-jumping competition in Tveitanbakken Friday and Saturday.
