## VENUE

Lysgårdsbakken Ski Jumping Venue in the Olympic Park in Lillehammer is a modern and newly modernized ski jumping hill built for the Winter Olympic Games in Lillehammer in 1994.

The HS138 hill record for winter ski jumping was set by Simon Amman (SUI) at 146m in 2009 and for summer ski jumping by Thomas Lobben (NOR) at 140.5m in 2007. The winter record on HS100 was set by Espen Bredesen (NOR) at 104m during the Olympics in 1994, and the summer record was set by Daniela Iraschko (AUT) at 106.5m in 2010.

## RACE OFFICE AND INFORMATION OFFICE

will be located **next to the ski lift in the Ski Jumping Hill.**

The information office will be open from Friday 7 September 10:00 to Sunday 9 September 17:00.

## BIBS

Bibs for official training and the ski jumping competitions will be distributed one hour before the competition in the Race Office.

## WAXING FACILITIES

You will find waxing cabins close to the Ski Jumping Hill - according to FIS rules.

## COMPETITION RULES

The number of participants in the competitions for both ladies and men must comply with official FIS competition rules and regulations.

## DOPING CONTROL

Doping control may be carried out at any FIS competition according to FIS Anti-Doping Rules.

## ECONOMY - INSURANCE

Financial conditions are according to the FIS Rules and regulations. All competitors are to be insured by their own National Ski Association and must have signed the Athletes Declaration. The Organisers have coverage for their own third party liability only.

## TEAM CAPTAINS' MEETINGS

**LADIES: Friday 7 September 13:00 / MEN: Friday 7 September 14:00**

The Team Captains' meetings will be held in the Ski Jumping Hill – in the grey school buildings.

## ACCOMMODATION

Reservation of rooms for all Teams and Officials are made at the **Nermo Hotel** in Øyer. The Organising Committee will cover the accommodation expenses according to the FIS Continental Cup SJ Nations' Quota for the summer 2012. For booked room reservations not used, the organiser has the right to demand a cancellation fee from the National Ski Associations (FIS rules).

## TRANSPORT

Bus transfer of the Teams from Oslo Airport Gardermoen to Lillehammer and return will be organised by the Organising Committee on Thursday 6 and Friday 7 September and for departure on Sunday 9 and Monday 10 September.

## TRANSPORT COST

From Oslo Airport to the hotel in Lillehammer and return the **price per person is NOK 500.**
