## GENERAL INFORMATION

### Accommodation

The accommodation for the FIS officials, team staffs and athletes will be in Rasnov. The hotels are located in a nice surrounding with easy access to all running paths. It takes about 5 minutes by bus to the ski jumping hill in Valea Cărbunarii. There will be a shuttle bus service from the hotel to the venue. The costs for full pension are 45 EURO /person /day accommodated in a double room, for single use will be an extra charge of 10 EURO /person/day. The payment will be done by the Organizing Committee only.

**Note: We cannot guarantee any rooms or prices after August 1, 2019.** For not used booked rooms, the organizer has the right to demand a cancellation fee from the National Ski Associations (FIS Cup Rules).

### Transportation

The Organizing Committee can provide transportation to and from the Otopeni Airport/Bucharest upon request. The cost of one way it is 35 euro/person. If you are travelling by your own transportation means, please announce your arrival time as well.
