Competition plan

1. Competition overview

The 14th National Winter Games Ski jumping Event will take place from January 2nd (Thursday) to January 5th (Sunday) 2020 in Planica, Slovenia.

2. Trainings

1) Schedule

(1) The pre-match training days have to be arranged by each team on their own. Booking of trainings can be made at the reception in the Hotel Planica or by email to: booking@nc-planica.si

2) Other matters

(1) During the training period before the competition, accommodation, transportation, and venue fees will be paid by the teams themselves.

(2) Each team should send the accommodation arrangements and the number of people during the training days and the competition to the hotel reservation contact for room reservation.

3. The Official competition of The 14th National Winter Games Ski jumping Event

1) Schedule

The Official competition of The 14th National Winter Games Ski jumping Event will be held from January 2nd till January 5th 2020 in Planica, Slovenia. The official competition consists of 4 days and is divided into 1 day for official training and 3 days for competition.

The competition time will be adjusted in real time according to the weather and other factors, and will be notified through the team leader meeting or during the competition. The specific competition schedule is as follows:

2) Entry requirements

(1) Age requirement :

Athletes are required to be born before December 31, 2007. (The information of the second generation ID card shall prevail.)

(2) Identity Regulations for Competition Items

Each participating representative should select suitable competition items according to the level of athletes themselves to ensure that athletes have the ability and safety to compete all competitions.

3) Expense

(1) During The 14th National Winter Games Ski Jumping Event (January 2-5), the food expenses (breakfast, lunch, dinner) and accommodation expenses of each team will be paid by themselves. The site fees during the competition will be provided by the competition organizing committee.

4) Athlete qualification and examination

The examination of qualification is carried out in accordance with the fourth provision in the General Regulations of The 14th National Winter Games Ski jumping Event.

Registered athletes must bring the original ID card when participating in the national competition. Before the competition, the organizing committee will check the electronic registration file with the original ID card or fingerprint information of the athlete, and then verify the qualification of the athlete after checking the correctness.

5) Safety requirement

All athletes must wear professional equipment certified by FIS when participating in the training and the competition, and all sports equipment should comply with the relevant safety regulations of FIS. Athletes who do not follow the safety regulations to participate in training and competition should bear the risk of safety responsibility by themselves. Athletes and coaches of each training and participating representative teams should sign the "Safety Responsibility Letter". Training and competing the athletes who will train and compete must buy their own insurance before they participate in the competition.

6) Competition Discipline and Anti-Doping Regulations

Athletes and coaches of each team should sign the "Competition Discipline Commitment Letter" and "Anti-doping Responsibility Letter".

7) Equipment Testing

Each delegation should own its own delegation flag and strictly implement it in accordance with Article 10 of the General Principles, that the Flag can not be marked except for the name of the participating team specified in the Regulations. The Organizing Committee of the Competition will inspect

or spot check the athletes' participating equipment before, during and after the competition. The participating equipment should conform to the provisions of FIS.
