## COVID-19 Prevention:

- National Ski Associations are responsible for leaving sick individuals at home. Anyone who shows symptoms of COVID-19 should not enter the United States.
- **All athletes and staff should have a negative test within 24 hours before flying to the United States.**
- **All Non-US Citizens must be fully vaccinated with an approved vaccine according to [CDC guidelines](#)**
- Under current regulations individuals are NOT required to undergo testing or quarantine when entering Utah.
  - Testing immediately after entering Utah is available for teams who request it.
    - All COVID-19-tests will be provided by local health authorities, and the cost of these test must be paid by all nations (together with all other costs and reimbursement).
    - **Positive Test:**
      - If the test confirms that you have COVID-19, you will be contacted and monitored by the health services. To avoid transferring the disease to others and stop the spread, you will need to stay in isolation.
- All athletes and support personnel are strongly recommended to stay in the accommodations offered by the OC.
- All COC teams will be located in the same section of the hotel to avoid interaction with non-competition individuals.
- Meals will be separate from non-competition individuals.
- **Testing will be made available for departure to Canada**

## Routines during your stay in Utah:

- Face masks are not required under current Summit County, Utah regulations, however:
  - We recommend you wear masks whenever possible
- Face masks will be required for all indoor spaces at the competition venues
  - Utah Olympic Park
  - Soldier Hollow
- Wash hands frequently and thoroughly with soap and lukewarm water.
- Use an alcohol-based disinfectant if soap and water is not available, especially when you have been in contact with other people
- Keep a distance of at least 1.5 meters to others
- Avoid coughing or sneezing directly onto others

FIS ICR Rules will apply. Athletes must have a valid FIS License.

## **FLIGHTS & TRANSPORTATION:**

## **INSURANCE:**

All competitors are to be insured by their own Ski Association

## **DOPING POLICIES AND PROCEDURES:**

FIS is committed to maintaining the integrity of all ski competitions. In order to prevent the use of forbidden substances or methods, doping controls can be carried out at any FIS sanctioned event.

## **COMPETITION OFFICE and ACCREDITATION**

The Competition Office will be located at the USANS Office located at 3419 Olympic Parkway, Park City, UT 84098. Upon arrival, all team leaders must report to the competition office for check-in and accreditation. Team check-in must be completed before using the competition venue. A map and location will be provided before arrival.

Officials and judges' travel reimbursement will be taken care of following the Team Captains Meeting on 10<sup>th</sup>.

## OPEN TRAINING

Open training is available on the hill before the event program begins and after it ends **depending on weather**. \*There is a per day \$35 athlete training fee before the 11<sup>th</sup> and after the 13<sup>th</sup> of March for any scheduled training sessions. Scheduling for open training needs to take place no later than 48 hours in advance with [mterwillegar@uolf.org](mailto:mterwillegar@uolf.org). Open Training at Soldier Hollow will also be available before. All participants will need to purchase a trail pass for open training (\$15 for adults, \$5 for U18)

**\*Training is of course weather dependent as it can get warm during the days at this time of year\***
