Entries

Entries have to be submitted via the FIS online entry system.

Final entry by name: Monday, 10.01.2022 12.00 hrs

Accommodation

Accommodation and meals will be granted by the OC according to the quota and the COC rules.

Room reservations, which are cancelled after the end of entry deadline, must be paid by the national ski federation (COCJ –M 6.1.1)

Entry form must contain the number of athletes and coaches as well as the date of arrival and departure. Otherwise the organiser can't guarantee the accommodation according to the rules of the COC.

Insurance

The organiser takes neither responsibility in case of accidents and the consequences, nor for third party risks. The participants have to proof an insurance for accidents.

Regulations of Visa

Remember that citizens of some countries will need visa for visiting Germany. Please check with your embassy if you need a visa for Germany.

Transportation

Please note that no transport service will be offered by the LOC.

Covid 19 regulations

Arrival in Germany

- Travellers who have visited a high-risk area or area of variant of concern in the last ten days must register at www.einreiseanmeldung.de before arriving in Germany and carry proof of registration with them upon entry. Exemptions to this registration requirement apply in particular to persons who
 - ⇒ have only passed through a high-risk area or area of variant of concern without a stopover,
 - ⇒ are only passing through Germany, or
 - ⇒ in the case of border traffic: persons who have spent less than 24 hours in a high-risk area or area of variant of concern or are only entering Germany for a period of up to 24 hours.

- Upon entering Germany, travellers aged twelve years or older must hold proof of the following:
 - ⇒ Entry from an area of variant of concern: negative COVID-19 test result (PCR not older than 72h or Antigentest not older than 24 h). Proof of a full COVID-19 vaccination or proof of recovery from an infection is not sufficient.
 - ⇒ Entry from high risk area: a negative COVID-19 test result (PCR not older than 72h or Antigentest not older than 48 h) or proof of a full COVID-19 vaccination or proof of recovery from an infection (not older than 6 months).

This proof must be held prior to entering the country and must be presented to the airline before departure where applicable.

- Proof of vaccination against COVID-19 in German, English, French, Italian or Spanish in digital or paper form (e.g. EU Digital COVID certificate; WHO vaccination booklet). Note that a photo of a proof in paper form is not sufficient. Also the vaccine used must be one of those listed on the website of the Paul-Ehrlich-Institut (**BionTech/ Pfizer, Astra Zeneca, Johnson& Johnson, Moderna**)

Exemptions from quarantine can be made for persons who are accredited by the respective organization committee for participation on an international sports event or have been invited by a national sports federation to participate in training measures. Please follow the steps of the online registration and select the point shown below for potential exemptions from the obligation to quarantine in the last step of registration.

Covid-19 testing procedure

For joining the event it will be necessary to full fill one of the so called 3G regulations what means:

1. Being vaccinated with a vaccine recognized in Germany
OR
 2. Being recovered (28 days after positive PCR-test until maximum 6 months after the first positive PCR-test)
OR
 3. Having a negative PCR-test not older than 48hrs before entering the venue on 15th January the first time (so test must be made on 13th or 14th January)
- **Following vaccinations are currently recognized/valid for events in Germany:**
 - BioNtech/Pfizer
 - AstraZeneca
 - Moderna
 - Janssen Pharmaceutica NV (Johnson & Johnson)

Please note that if you are vaccinated with any other vaccine it will be seen as unvaccinated!

In order to receive an NSA/Team- accreditation, the respective person must provide the following and present it at the OC – Office on Friday or Saturday before the competition:

- Nomination on the entry list
- Vaccination or recovery certificate or negative PCR-test result (digital or paper)
- Personal identification card

Accommodation

- Official regulations for hotels are that only vaccinated or recovered persons with a valid EU certificate are accepted (German 2G)
- For professional stays there is an exception that instead of vaccination a valid PCR test not older than 48h can be accepted (German 3G+), however hotels are not obliged to accept 3G+ and might only accept 2G
- If you don't have a valid EU certificate of vaccination or recovery, please contact your hotel to check on their regulations!
- Every team member is obliged to stay in their designated hotel for the duration of the event.
- Wear a FFP2-face mask in all public areas.
- In the buffet area a face mask is also obligatory but can be put down at the table.
- Further hygiene measures are presented in the hotel.
- All hotels follow the regulations of the German Health Department.

Regulations at the venue

- Always keep social distancing!
- **FFP2-Face Masks** are mandatory in the whole venue area! Except:
 - During sports exercise
 - During warm up & directly before start
 - During meals

Covid-19 Communication/ Contacts

- In case of a positive test result, the following behavior rules need to be followed:
 - Self-isolation
 - Team hygiene and LOC hygiene staff will be informed
 - Local health authorities will be informed
 - Further measures will be coordinated by the local health authorities
